
# **NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2016**

MINUTES OF THE 30<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF ST. LAWRENCE OLD BOYS' ASSOCIATION HELD ON SUNDAY, 27<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2015 AT 11.00 AM AT FR. WAVREIL HALL IN THE SCHOOL PREMISES

- The attendance was recorded as per the Attendance Register.
- President of SLOBA, Rev. Fr. Sebastian James sj called the meeting to order and on the request of the Secretary, Mr. Anirban Banerjee, took the chair. Rev. Fr. Jeyaraj Velusamy sj, Provincial of the Calcutta Jesuit Order and Rev. Fr. Joseph Toppo sj were also requested to be on the dais.
- Members observed minute's silence in memory of Rev. Fr. Andre Bruylants sj and Dr. P. G. Roy who left for their Heavenly Abode during the year.
- Rev Fr. Jeyaraj Velusamy sj was presented a flower bouquet by Mr. Saptarshi Ghosh.

Agenda 1: To receive, consider and confirm the proceedings of the 29<sup>th</sup> AGM held on 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2014: Mr. Anirban Banerjee presented the minutes of the 29<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 which was confirmed after deliberations on the proceedings being proposed by Mr. Amitava Gupta and seconded by Mr. G. P. Gupta.

Agenda 2: To receive, consider and adopt the Annual Report for the year 2014-2015 (ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2015) of the working of the Society (Secretary's Report): The Annual Report for the year 2014-2015 of the working of the Association was placed before the house by Mr. Anirban Banerjee for discussion. He said that the Annual Report was already circulated and highlighted the activities and events carried out by SLOBA during the year. The report after being proposed by Mr. Ajay Kumar Pandey and seconded by Mr. Kalyan Gupta was adopted unanimously by the house.

Agenda 4: To appoint Auditors and Bankers for the year 2015-2016: The next agenda to appoint Auditors and Bankers for the year 2015-2016 was moved by Mr. Anirban Banerjee. He proposed to reappoint M/s. S. Rudra & Co. as Auditors of SLOBA for the year 2015-2016 and to continue with Syndicate bank as bankers of SLOBA for the year 2015-2016 which were unanimously accepted by the house.

Mr. Caesar Sen informed the house that as per existing norms, Mr. S. V. Raman, Mr. Shankar Banerjee and Mr. Kalpajeet Basu Mallik had retired and Mr. Krishnendu Sengupta had resigned from the Governing Body of SLOBA as such there were four vacancies to be filled by means of election. Pharmaceutical companies, and several old boys have been consistent and generous in their support to our clinic and we gratefully acknowledge their assistance. A special thanks to Dr. Soumitra Kumar for regularly monitoring the activities of the Free Clinic and Dr. Anand has also been working tirelessly to ensure a steady supply of medicine to the clinic.

# **School Development & Scholarship**

It is a well-known fact that SLOBA has instituted several scholarships and other benevolent funds in association with the school management over the years. While the Golden Jubilee Scholarship Fund and the Golden Jubilee Staff Welfare Fund are known to all, there are several smaller funds which are not properly documented. We shall be taking up this matter both with the donors as well as the school management shortly to sort matters out by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 for a comprehensive list of all such donations and awards made to the institution and the current status.

A small change has been made by the Governing Body towards disbursement of funds under the Golden Jubilee Staff Welfare Fund. As the disbursement amount of RS. 20,000=00 to retiring teachers is no longer substantial, it is decided that teachers will be presented with suitable mementos and gifts on retirement as a token of gratitude. An amount of RS. 20,000=00 will now instead be given to non-teaching staff on retirement.
