- Mr. Anand Singh briefed how SLOBA in association with the school has been encouraging the
 youth in their development with dedicated activities of Sports and culture such as SLOBA
 cricket coaching camps, organizing and participating tournaments. He also mentioned
 "EXPRESSION" which has been instrumental in engaging students in various activities.
- Dr. Soumitra Kumar through an elaborate power point presentation briefed everyone present
 in the AGM that most of the disease that are being reported in the country are mostly related

There being no other matter, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and Members.


