MINUTES OF 36th ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF ST. LAWRENCE OLD BOYS' ASSOCIATION (SLOBA) HELD ON SUNDAY, 26th September 2021 AT ST. LAWRENCE HIGH SCHOOL, 27 BULLYGUNGE CIRCULAR ROAD, KOLKATA 700019

The attendance was recorded as per the Attendance Register.

President of SLOBA, Rev. Fr. Sebastian James sj called the meeting to order and on request of the President, Hon. Secretary, Mr. Anirban Banerjee, took the chair.

Members observed a minute's silence in memory of SLOBA members who left for their Heavenly Adobe during the year.

Free Clinic

The free clinic and all its activities resumed on October 21.

Oxygen Parlour & Vaccination Programs

SLOBA, in partnership with OFFER, a NGO set up a functional COVID Level 2 Oxygen Parlour in the school. This was a great initiative during the time when medical emergencies due to Covid were

increasing. Under a similar initiative SLOBA and OFFER initiated 3 vaccination camps which served over 400 people.

This initiative was repeated in Amtala in Kolkata, Mumbai and Bengaluru too. We catered to 180 people in Amtala, 450 at Mumbai and 170 at Bengaluru.

SLOBA funded Rs. 75,000/- to Offer India to support education of the 125 HIV positive children staying at their Orphanage Anandaghar at Govindapur, Kolkata.

School Development & Scholarship

SLOBA has instituted several scholarships and other benevolent funds in association with the school management over the years. These are disbursed by the school authorities on a merit cum means basis even though no regular classes could be held for the entire year.

SLOBA Cricket Coaching Camp

The activities resumed on 20th of March 22, after two years of inactivity due to pandemic.

We have been holding an **Annual Inter-School Debate** since the last ten years with participation from all the eminent schools of Kolkata and celebrities, educators, legislators, industrialists and other prominent personalities from the fields of art and culture as judges and moderators. The entire event is managed by SLOBA itself. The event made a comeback after two years of the pandemic when regular physical classes and other physical events remained suspended.

This year the **14**th **SLOBA ANNUAL INTER-SCHOOL DEBATE 2019** was held on **Friday 12**th **August 2022** at Wavreil Hall at **St. Lawrence High School,** *27 Ballygunge Circular Road Kolkata 700 019* **from 10.30 .m. to 12.30 p.m. The motion for the debate was: Social Media Has Made a Mockery of True Friendship.**

The judges for the finals were Ms. Jael Silliman (Eminent Author, Professor and Novelist), Mr. Devasis (Eminent Professional Consultant and Mentor for Entrepreneurship Skills) and Ms. Shampa Mukherji (Teacher at Modern High School for Girls and Garden High International School). Proposed amendments to the Rules and Regulations of SLOBA

Rule 22 Clause (b)

SAFE CUSTODY OF FUNDS:

(b) The funds of the Society shall be kept in some nationalized Bank.

To be amended as:

(b) The funds of the Society shall be kept in some nationalized Bank <u>or any private Indian Bank</u> <u>authorized by the Reserve Bank of India to conduct full banking operations in India.</u>

EXPLANATION

The original clause in the Constitution was introduced at a time when the number of private banks was limited to only a few multinational banks dealing only in large sums of money. Now that private Indian banks are already certified as too big to fail, it is prudent to maintain financial relations with these banks as these are more customer friendly and offer better services and facilities particularly for new age digital products and retail monetary transactions like bill discounting etc.
